- No more than 10 slides
- 30 Point font
- Use visuals
- Make it engaging



# The Beginning

#### Title Slide

app logo, team name, mission

#### Problem/Opportunity

- Describe your problem and solution
- Use a visual, tell a story

#### Value proposition

Why your solution is unique and solves the problem

### The Middle

#### App solution

Describe your app and features

#### Business model

Who are your users and how will you make money

#### Market Plan

How will you reach your customers

#### Competitive Analysis

Who are competitors and why are you better

### The End

#### Team

Your team roles, your advisors

#### Projections and milestones

- Your current status, next milestones
- Senior team your financial projections

#### Close

- Get your message across one last time
- Ask your audience for funding, help, use your app

## **Strong Opening**

Ask a Question.

"Have you ever tried to find a great babysitter?"

Imagine.

"Imagine for a moment that you could not afford lunch"

Statistics.

"Did you know that 20% of homeless are youth..."

Quote.

"As Malala said – Education is education"

### **Build Your Confidence**

- Practice pitching
- Have friends and family ask you questions
- Pitch to a mirror
- Get your mentor feedback



## Handling Questions

- Practice getting questions
- Listen
- Don't get defensive
- If you are not sure what the judge is asking, clarify
- Don't be afraid to say you don't know
  - "I don't know that answer, but what I can tell you is ...
